She had not been to a restaurant to eat in over a year. She couldn't afford to stay at the half-way house any longer due to the others relapsing. Not all homeless women are unemployed. Going to a nice restaurant, laughing, talking, and sharing a meal with a girlfriend was like the "old times" for her. It made her feel valuable.
